College of Business

Persuasion and influence are powerful tools for shaping the beliefs, attitudes, and behaviors of others. This interactive session will explore the skills used to shape thoughts, opinions, and actions through solid communication and by appealing to emotions, logic, and credibility. Pharmacy

Join us for an engaging workshop that offers a glimpse into the NDSU Pharmacy Program and its exciting career paths. This hands-on session will not only introduce you to the dynamic world of pharmacy but also let you get creative by compounding your own custom-scented lip balm. Learn about the program's offerings, career opportunities, and the science behind pharmaceutical compounding. Physics

This interactive session will push the limits of how we see the material world around us, spanning scales from a single DNA molecule to the entire Universe. Participants will still be breathing air in and out after the session, but the mindset of doing so will likely be different.

Precision Agriculture Technology & Management

Students will learn Ag Machine principles, data mapping, field sprayer, and electrical systems.
